

# ADVANCED CONFLICT RESOLUTION IN WISE TIMETABLE

#### Introduction

Wise Timetable includes one of the most advanced conflict detection and resolution mechanisms available for academic scheduling. Instead of searching manually through the timetable, conflicts are highlighted immediately, so you always know where the problem lies. Conflicts can appear when a tutor, room, or group is double-booked, or when special constraints are not respected.

## Types of conflicts

- Overlapping lectures for the same tutor, room, or group.
- Violations of special constraints (time preferences, room capacity, equipment needs).
- Scheduling limits exceeded (maximum daily or weekly workload).
- Exceptions set by the university that need specific approval.

### **Conflict analysis**

Individual conflicts can be seen immediately on all the main screen views – presented by different colors. The most obvious one is not overlapping but "conflict" in a way that schedule is not scheduled at all! As a general rule, inside Wise Timetable you can see unscheduled classes (planned but without time and date set) are NOT colored in yellow:








Here we see that one course is not scheduled completely – so it is not scheduled completely.

If we go further, inside the course, we see that only one course modality (seminar) is not colored yellow, which means we have to schedule only this one:




When we see that, we can just click on the same screen on the button "->SCHEDULE" and software will show us where we can put it without overlapping.

To see the analysis for the WHOLE timetable, just go to Analysis->View Conflicts:

This screen will show you all the conflicts inside your timetable. To resolve the conflicts just click on the conflict line to see all the details. Software will change the view (including date, week) into that conflict position – by clicking on the "SHOW" button. There you can easily resolve the conflict – e.g. move overlapping class to some other position/slot.

#### Individual conflicts

Individual conflicts are always shown immediately in DARK GREY color. For example, here we have individual conflict shown on the Main screen:
